#### SCRAPTOFT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN DECISION STATEMENT

# 1. Summary

- 1.1 Following an Independent Examination, Harborough District Council now confirms that the Scraptoft Neighbourhood Plan will proceed to a Neighbourhood Planning Referendum.

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## 2. Background

- 2.1 In July 2012 Scraptoft Parish Council, as the qualifying body, applied for Scraptoft Parish to be designated as a Neighbourhood Area for the purpose of preparing a neighbourhood plan. The Neighbourhood Area application was approved by Harborough District Council (the Council) on 29 October 2012 in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations (2012)
- 2.2 Following the submission of the Scraptoft Neighbourhood Plan to the Council, the Plan was publicised and representations were invited. The consultation period closed on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2015.
- 2.3 The Council, with the agreement of Scraptoft Neighbourhood Plan Group, appointed an independent examiner, Dr Angus Kennedy, to review whether the Plan met the Basic Conditions required by legislation and should proceed to referendum.
- 2.4 The Examiner's Report concludes that, subject to making the modifications proposed by the Examiner, the Neighbourhood Plan meets the Basic Conditions set out in the legislation and should proceed to a Neighbourhood Planning referendum.

#### 3. Decision and Reasons

3.1 At its meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2015, the Council agreed that the Examiner's recommended modifications should be accepted and that the amended

- Neighbourhood Plan should proceed to a referendum (see Council resolution at Appendix 1).
- 3.2 The District Council has made the modifications, proposed by the examiner, to secure that the draft plan meets the basic conditions. Appendix 2 sets out these modifications and the action to be taken in respect of each of them.
- 3.3 The Council agrees with the Examiner's recommendation that there is no reason to extend the Neighbourhood Plan area (Scraptoft Parish) for the purpose of holding the referendum.
- The Examiner has concluded that with the specified modifications the Plan meets the basic conditions and other relevant legal requirements. The Council concurs with this view. Therefore to meet the requirements of the Localism Act 2011 a referendum which poses the question 'Do you want Harborough District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Scraptoft to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?' will be held in the Parish of Scraptoft.
- 3.5 The date on which the referendum will take place is agreed as **Thursday 11**<sup>th</sup> **February 2016**.
