

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary election For the Rutland and Melton constituency

1. An Election is to be held for of a Member of Parliament to serve Rutland and Melton Constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Acting Returning Officer at Parkside, Station Approach, Burton Street, Melton Mowbray, LE13 1GH, during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at Parkside, Station Approach, Burton Street, Melton Mowbray, LE13 1GH on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4 p.m. on Thursday 11th May 2017.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on 8th June 2017.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Symington Building, Adam and Eve Street, Market Harborough, LE16 7AG by 12 midnight on Monday 22nd May 2017.
6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Symington Building, Adam and Eve Street, Market Harborough LE16 7AG by 5 p.m. on Tuesday 23rd May 2017.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Symington Building, Adam and Eve Street, Market Harborough LE16 7AG by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 31st May 2017.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Symington Building, Adam and Eve Street, Market Harborough LE16 7AG by 5 p.m. on 8th June 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 31st May 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 p.m. on Wednesday 31st May 2017.
