SHARING INFORMATION WITH YOUR LANDLORD				
Sometimes, sharing information with your landlord helps us deal with your claim more quickly and reduces the risk of you falling behind with your rent because of your claim being delayed. We would only share information with your landlord if you:  A Have agreed that we can pay your bousing benefit straight to your landlord.

But in either case, under the Data Protection Act, we need your permission to share information. If you give us permission, we would be able to tell your landlord:

- Whether or not you had claimed for housing benefit and, if so, whether or not we have made a decision on your claim; and
- If we need more information to make a decision on your claim and, if so, what information this is

There may be other information about your claim that we need to check with your landlord, such as the date your tenancy started, before we can make a decision on your claim. If this is the case, we have to ask your landlord if you have not given us permission to discuss your claim with them. But unless you have given us permission by signing this form, we will not discuss anything else with your landlord.
