Subject matter

Harborough District Council submitted the Harborough Proposed Submission Local Plan (2011 to 2031) (the Plan) to the Secretary of State in March 2018 for Examination. Examination Hearings were held by the Planning Inspector Jonathan Bore BA MRTPI DipUD in October 2018.

Following the Hearings, a number of Main Modifications have been prepared at the request of the Planning Inspector. A Main Modification is an amendment which is considered necessary to make the Plan sound, and is required in order to address concerns raised by the Inspector or other representors during the examination process. The Council has prepared a schedule setting out the proposed Main Modifications it considers necessary in order for the Local Plan to be found sound.

Period for representations

The consultation runs for six weeks from noon on Tuesday 15th January 2019 to noon on Tuesday 26th February 2019. **Representations must arrive no later than noon on Tuesday 26th February 2019.**
