The purpose of a neighbourhood forum is to act as the representative body who undertake neighbourhood planning. A neighbourhood forum has to consist of a minimum of 21 individuals and be open to those who live or work in the area.

In accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) should the designation be made no other organisation or body may be designated for that neighbourhood area until that designation expires or is withdrawn.

Neighbourhood Planning:

Communities are able to produce a statutory 'neighbourhood plan' to be used by the Local Planning Authority when determining planning applications, but also grant 'permitted development' rights for certain types of new development. Saddington Parish Neighbourhood Forum (2021 to 2026) has also applied to designate an amended neighbourhood area (currently being advertised by HDC).

- consider representations and make a decision whether to designate a neighbourhood forum and area.

Once a neighbourhood forum is designated it can then engage and consult with the wider community to develop a plan for their neighbourhood.

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
