Foxton Review Neighbourhood Development Plan - Final Decision Statement Notice

- 1.1. Following independent examination Harborough District Council (HDC) is publishing its decision to 'make' the Foxton Review Neighbourhood Development Plan part of Harborough District Councils Development Plan in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.
- 1.2. With the Examiner's recommended modifications, the Foxton Review Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the basic conditions set out in paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 48 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, is compatible with EU obligations and the Convention rights and complies with relevant provision made by or under Section 38A and B of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 as amended.
- 1.3. Cabinet approved the Foxton Review Neighbourhood Plan to be 'made' at its meeting on 1 November 2021.
- 1.4. Harborough District Council has assessed that the Plan, including its preparation, does not breach, and would not otherwise be incompatible with, any EU obligation or any Convention rights (within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 1998).
- 1.5. In accordance with the Regulations and the Council's scheme of delegation the Foxton Neighbourhood Development Plan is 'made' and planning applications in the Parish must be considered against the Foxton Review Neighbourhood Development Plan, as well as existing planning policy, such as the Harborough District Local Plan and the National Planning Policy Framework and Guidance.
