
Application for Designation of Fleckney Neighbourhood Area for Fleckney Parish Council (The Qualifying Body)

Fleckney Parish Council as the Qualifying Body for the purposes of section 61G of the 1990 Act and the application is in compliance with Part 2 Regulation 5 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 to prepare a Neighbourhood Development Plan for Fleckney.

In 2016 Fleckney Parish Council applied to designate the entire parish of Fleckney as a Neighbourhood Area. The designation notice was published by Harborough District Council (HDC) on 24 March 2016 after 6 weeks publicity.

As a result of HDC's Community Governance Review in 2020/21 the parish boundary between Saddington and Fleckney changed on 1st April 2022. Fleckney Parish Council is therefore applying for a revised Fleckney Neighbourhood Area to be designated in accordance with Part 2 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

The area to be covered by Fleckney's Neighbourhood Plan is the revised Fleckney Parish as approved by HDC following the 2020/21 Community Governance Review. A map showing the area to be designated is shown below with the boundary shown in red.



It is considered that the Neighbourhood Area detailed above is appropriate to be designated as it is the formal geographical boundary of Fleckney which wholly contains Fleckney village and other community amenities., The residents of Fleckney village and people who are employed within Fleckney parish value the identity and sense of community within the parish boundary and therefore wish to maintain Fleckney's Neighbourhood Plan for the future development and benefit of Fleckney Parish.
