



Principle	Description
Selflessness	Volunteers should act solely in terms of the public interest.
Integrity	Volunteers must avoid placing themselves under any obligation to people or organisations that might try inappropriately to influence them in their work. They should not act in order to gain financial or other material benefits for themselves, their family, or their friends.
Objectivity	Volunteers must act impartially, fairly and on merit, using the best evidence and without discrimination or bias.
Accountability	Volunteers are accountable to the public for their actions and must submit themselves to any scrutiny necessary to ensure this.
Openness	Volunteers should act in an open and transparent manner.
Honesty	Volunteers should be truthful.
Leadership	Volunteers should exhibit these principles in their own behaviour. They should actively promote and robustly support the principles of the policy and be willing to challenge poor behaviour wherever it occurs.
Respect	Volunteers must treat others with respect at all times and have confidence and trust in others, on the understanding that this is reciprocal.
