This data is sourced from Land Registry's Price Paid Data which tracks the residential property sales in England and Wales that are sold for full market value and submitted to them for registration.

Price Paid Data excludes:

sales that have not been lodged with Land Registry.

sales that were not for full market value. By this we mean, the sale of part of a property, a share of a property or the sale of a property at a discount. For examples a transfer between parties on divorce, transfers, conveyances, assignments or leases at a premium with nominal rent which are:

- 'Right to buy' sales at a discount

- subject to a lease

- subject to an existing mortgage

- to effect the sale of a share in a property

- by way of a gift

- under a compulsory purchase order

- under a court order

- to Trustees appointed under Deed of appointment

- Vesting Deeds Transmissions or Assents of more than one property

- leases for seven years or less

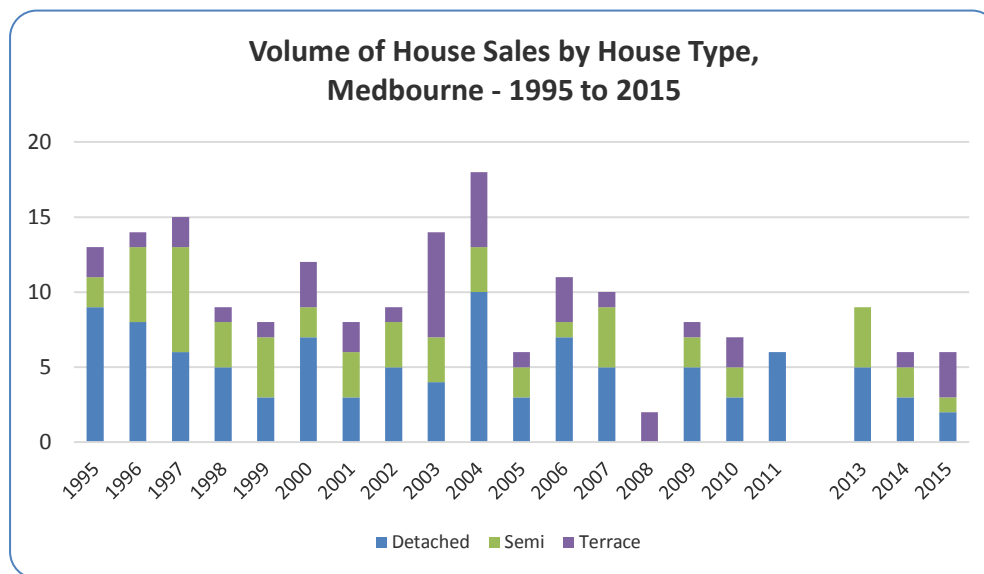

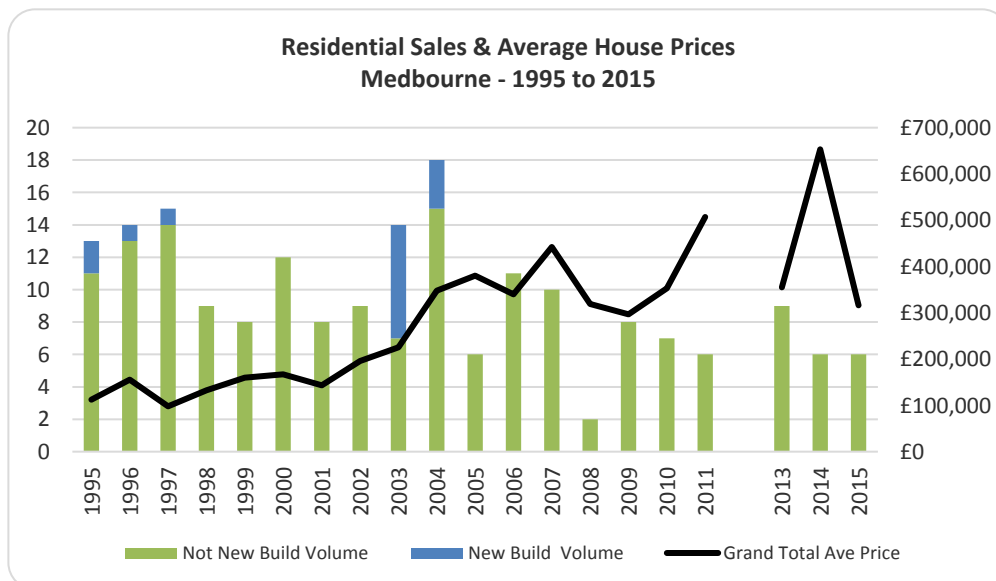

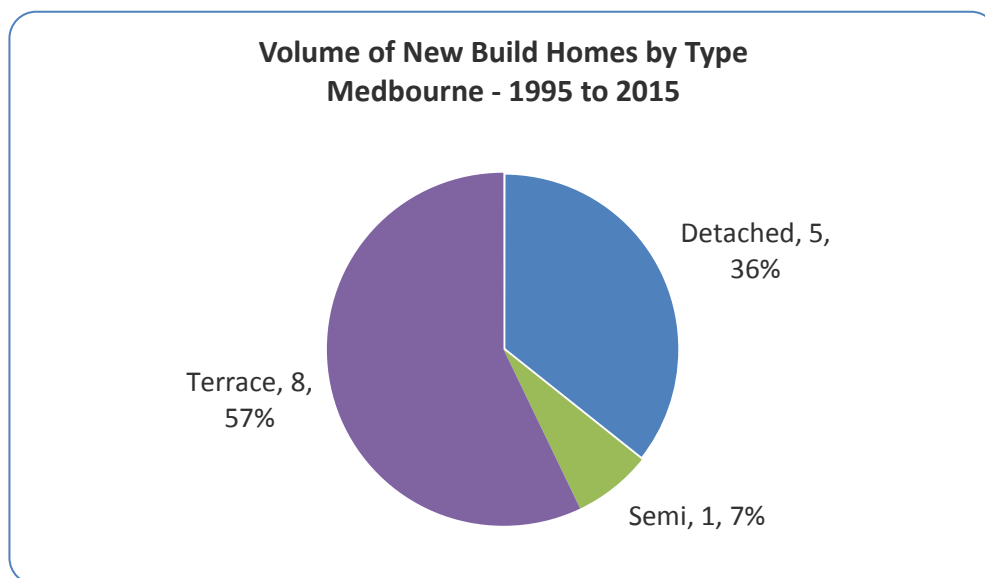
