Factual Updates - 15th May 2025

Following the publication of the Health Impact Assessment in February 2025 it has been necessary to make several factual corrections to the document. These corrections are listed below:


1. Page 31

The air quality for Harborough is everall in safe levels conducive to health. However, there are het spots shown below, with higher levels in some parts, mainly in Lutterworth area. Information from Inhale Fingertips data shows rates of hospital admissions in under 19 year olds for Harborough and for England overall for 2022/2023 and 2023/2024. The number of hospital admissions in Harborough was 47.0 per 100.00 in 2022/2023, which increased to 69.2 per 100,00 in 2023/24. However, the rates are lower than the England value of 122.2 per 100.000 in 2022/23 and 148.6 per 100,00 in 2023/24, which require monitoring and intervention. This is made clear when discussing Figure 40, where a cluster of asthma and wheeze hospital admissions are presented on the map correlating with the poorer air quality.
